Applying as an International Student at Immaculata Regional High School

We would be happy to learn more about your son /daughter as a possible student here next year. In order for us to consider him/her as a possible student, we must have some pertinent information.

1. Fill out the application form found on our school web-site.
2. Provide a copy of his/her most current report card from his/her current school.
3. Provide a letter of reference from the Principal/Head-Master of his/her current school.
4. Provide a letter from his/her teacher of English as to the level of his/her English Language proficiency.

After these documents are received, I will determine if we are able to provide a proper program for him/her. If I am sure that we will be able to ensure a good academic year for your child, I will send you a letter confirming acceptance and requesting payment of tuition fees in full. This is a requirement of both our School Board and the Immigration Ministry for any international student studying in Canada. Once the fees are received, I will forward to you, the final letter of acceptance which you will need to take to apply for a Student Visa from Canada Immigration.

Upon arrival at Immaculata, please have a copy of the following documents to give to the secretary:

1. Final Report Card.
2. Proof of Medical Insurance.
3. Passport.
4. Student Visa.

To ensure that all these requirements are met in a timely manner, I would suggest that you apply in March or April. This will allow your child to have a report card that shows how he/she is doing this year in his/her school, and will allow you to see the most up-to-date application form and fee schedule from our school.

If you have any further questions, please let me know and I will answer them the best I can. We have a number of wonderful international students at our school and look forward to learning more about your child.
